As anticipated in the recent PT-PC T2S Change Management, we wish to remind you that the upcoming 3.0 release of T2S will implement, inter alia, change request 612, the purpose of which is to adapt communication messages with T2S to the ISO 20022 – 2017 standard.

An additional notice indicating the defects included in the release and the module for indicating willingness to test the software will follow according to the usual timeframe.

#### Test schedule

Testing in the UTEST environment will be possible starting on 22 March 2019 until, indicatively, the date of implementation of the release, 7 June 2019. Additional details will be announced in the upcoming notice regarding the full scope of the release.
