Disaster Recovery Simulation 2017 May 20th

Dear Client,

Please be informed that on 20 May 2017, Monte Titoli will perform a Disaster Recovery Simulation on Production environment using “real data”.

Business date 22 May 2017 will be used in the simulation.

The simulation has been defined in accordance with recommendations issued by the Bank of Italy and international organisations, and is in line with the required standards for settlement service managers.

Concerning Regulations about services of centralised administration, settlement, guarantee systems and the relevant management companies (Bank of Italy Regulation of 11 and 24 February 2015), in particular Annex 1, “Guidelines for Business Continuity of Centralised Administration, Settlement and Guarantee systems”, Bank of Italy sets out main criteria which entities involved must follow to ensure the continuous and efficient operation of managed services.

The purpose of the initiative is to verify that members of settlement services possess appropriate organisational and technological systems in accordance with Article 12 (1), letter b) of the General Conditions Part II. .

A detailed report about the simulation outcomes will be forwarded to the Authority.

We inform that all MT-X, X-TRM On-line and MT-A2A connections will be active in Disaster Recovery mode and available for the simulation.

Concerning to the method of connection through MT-A2A, we recommend that operators use their own technicians to verify availability and connectivity on Disaster Recovery.
