Dear Client,

We are pleased to announce that, as per previous ON_07/2018 published on 06 February, activities for adaptation to international standards and to market practice for the reporting of the settlement of Market Claims and Reverse Market Claims ("Claims") have been completed.

Consequently, Monte Titoli has prepared the testing activities for the new final 7B2 message and the new MT566 NEWM CLAI message. These new messages are associated with the pre-existing forecast 7B2 and SWIFT MT564 REPE CLAI messages.

Test and release dates

Testing of the new applications is scheduled from 05 March to 23 March 2018 and will be conducted in the Monte Titoli test environment named "Pre-production", which is connected to the T2S test environment named "UTEST".

The release into production, subject to successful testing, is scheduled for 26 March 2018. A follow-up call in the frame of the Post-Trade Participants Committee Custody working group is scheduled on 19 March 2018 in order to touch base on the progress of all external testing activities.

During the above mentioned call, intermediaries who participated to the testing will be invited to provide their GO/NO GO feedback by 21 March 2018 by sending an email to : helpdesk.domesticcustody@lseg.com.

Monte Titoli will consider the absence of feedback by 21 March 2018 as tacit consent to the production launch
